Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The manuscript is well-structured, the problem is good described, the equations suggested and considered are correct.</p> <p>I have only one remark, namely, the author(s) could add one more reference to their work: V. Krasnoholovets, Structure of Space and the Submicroscopic Deterministic Concept of Physics, Apple Academic Press (2017). The point is that in the book a detailed theory of real physical space is presented, i.e. a theory of a physical vacuum, which consists of primary topological balls that form a dense mathematical lattice. So the universe looks like a huge ball filled with topological balls whose diameter gradually increases from the center to the periphery and then a kind of the Young-Laplace pressure proportional to $1/r$ is responsible for an inner pressure, which we perceive as 'dark energy'. So, the book support the results obtained by the author(s).</p>
