<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	The purpose statement of the study is insufficient. There are numerous spelling and punctuation errors in the text. The spelling of degree signs is incorrect. Abstract wasn't written according to the journal pattern. Abstract isn't contain an keywords. Some parts of the text are single line spacing, some places are 1.5 lines and some are 2 lines. The absence of a control group (no cola nitida consumption) in the study is a major deficiency in evaluating the effectiveness of the results. Thirst perception values of a normal person during the day should be compared with the thirst perception values of a person consuming cola nitida.	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	I have no minor revision.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	Most people can safely tolerate about 400 milligrams of caffeine per day. It may be useful to quantify how much caffeine Cola nitida contains.
