Distorted and repetitive statements should be edited. Check the tracked changes of the manuscript. <p>Introduction section:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2- Abbreviations should be clearly defined in this section at first use. (e.g.DDVP) 3- The citations for the sentences "In Nigerian society, 2, 2 dichlorovinyl dimethylphosphate (sniper) is marketed by Swiss Chemical Nigerian limited" is not correct. Check the references list and add the correct reference for this sentence. 4- Check suggestions as shown on the line 16,18,20,21,23,27,28,30,31,38,etc. which is underlined as tracked changes. 5- Line 42-46, there are repetitive statements. These sentences need to rephrased. 6- "Adequate information is not available on the actual toxicological findings in the deceased in order to differentiate between sniper intoxicated deaths and disguised or homicidal death" should be check and rephrased the sentences. <p>Materials and Methods section:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1-"2.2 Procurement and administration of Sniper" should rephrased. 2-Write the trademark and country, etc. of the autoanalyzer. Write the ELISA reader trademark and country and all the test kits catalog number in section "2.4.2 Laboratory Investigation of Parameters". 3- Write the mathematical values of the all the biochemical parameters in the text or below the figures.(mean±SD). <p>Results and Discussion Section:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1-Write the lengthy of the "ns,s" in below or down of the figure. 2-Check suggestions as shown on the line which is underlined as tracked changes. 3- Rewrite the "conclusion" section. It should expand it a bit more clearly for readers. <p>References section:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1-Number 1. Ref. : check the title of the article. It should be written "Histological" Instead of "Toxicological" 2-Number 2.ref. : the title has missing words.
