<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	I suggest the Authors: This paper seems to be covering a very interesting topic, investigating the <b>Efficacy evaluation of abiotic elicitors for the management of black rot disease of cauliflower incited by <i>Xanthomonas campestris pv. campestris</i></b> . While the topic is potentially interesting, I found this paper nearly challenging to read because the language was particularly difficult. Many sentences seemed to try to smash together 3 or 4 ideas into a single, awkward sentence that used a variety of clauses to try to link the ideas. I found myself having to reread nearly every sentence to extract meaning. The Literature Section is missing. I recommend the authors to present the novelty of this research compared to previous research.
