Did the boy have fever or swollen submental or cervical lymph nodes?</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>Page 3, last paragraph of the introduction: the statement "The aim of this study ..." appears inappropriate for a case report. I suggest to change this to "We here present a rare case ..." and adapt the wording accordingly.</p> <p>Page 4, bottom, section "Presentation of case": statement "Treatment of corticosteroids of high potency". Please provide more detailed information about the exact drug and the type of ointment base". Additionally: please rename the header to "Case presentation" or "Presentation of the case".</p>
