Compulsory REVISION comments	Straight forward manuscript assessing antimicrobial activities of honey and selected medicinal plants. The methodology adopted is satisfactory and also the manuscript is well written and acceptable. But revision is recommended: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Authors stated that standard laboratory cultures were used for this study. Ideally standard strains (eg. ATCC) could have been used and when lab cultures are used, it is important that the characteristics of the strains should be provided including its actual drug resistance patterns.2. As there are seasonal variation in activities, it is important to mention that the month of honey and plants that were used for the study need to be mentioned.3. It is important to give complete details of how Phytochemical constituents were tested along with the testing methodologies.
