The applied statistical method is adequate for the study. The study is interesting and the paper is worth accepting.</p> <p>Yet, some corrections and editing are necessary:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applying spell and grammar check will help to avoid spelling mistakes and typo errors, including missing commas, spaces, subject verb agreement, etc.</li> <li>2. For the good order, the full name has to be added when an abbreviation is used for the first time in the text.</li> <li>3. It is better to avoid statements as "Telemedicine technology first introduced in the areas of healthcare delivery in late 1960s due to the operational needs of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)<sup>1</sup>." on page 1 and "Telehealth, also known as telemedicine" on page 2. The first is not correct, while telehealth and telemedicine are not accepted as synonyms in many countries. .</li> </ol>
