Although this sentence of "Twelve cases are presented here among a few cases of spontaneous abortion or fetal demise without having remarkable cause other than laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 (RT-PCR) from March 2020 to July 2020 in a single medical university hospital in Bangladesh" has no verb (which must be corrected), but I think this sentence must be upgraded in a more complete approach because it is the objective of your work (I mean you should state the goal of your study clearer). 3. This sentence (specimen was nasal swab) is not complete grammarly because it has no verb. Must be revised. 4. How many cases? Most of them is not clear. <p>INTRODUCTION:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. I think you should add a valid reference for the sentence "Physiological and Mechanical Changes enhance infection rate, especially Respiratory tract infection. Early pregnancy is a challenging and vulnerable period and affects embryogenesis and fetal organ development". 6. What is this confusing phrase of "very few there were very few"? <p>CASE SERIES:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 7. In this section, all variables of G1P0, G1P1, and G2P1 must be explained and defined clearly. 8. In the valuable table 1. The extended forms of BMI, GA, G1P, G2P, COVID, and Asymp. are necessary to be stated as the subtitle of the table. 9. Write Case No-1 similar to other cases. 10. The extended for of OPD in necessary. <p>DISCUSSION:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 11. Although the discussion part was written perfectly, but I recommend you in a non-mandatory process to add some scientific sentences to the discussion. Adding some new references about scientific aspect of abortion following respiratory infections can accelerate the validity of your work and citation. 12. This sentence (The previous reports are saying in pregnant women a mild form of the COVID-19 is developed having very few cases of mortality and perinatal demise) is confusing and has various writing mistakes which needs correction. <p>REFERENCES:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 13. All references were designed and selected precisely and no problem was found.
