The study proposed by the authors should be defined a case series. - The introduction content itself is not consistent with the title; furthermore, none of the clinical cases reported involves a surgical approach. - Case Reports are described in an inadequate way: anamnestic, radiological and clinical data of the patients are poor and muddled. - The manuscript needs extensive revision for language and grammar. The scientific English is totally inadequate and the manuscript content presents severe deficiencies. - The abbreviations employed are not clarified. <p>In conclusion, this manuscript has no scientific rigor.</p>
