They have found that he proton MR spectroscopy can be used to diagnose and follow developmental delay in children more than two years as they noticed typical changes in NAA/Cr and Cho/Cr. Proton MR spectroscopy should be performed as part of the neuroimaging evaluation of developmental delay, so should be a diagnostic tool and neuroimaging marker as is a non-invasive diagnostic test for measuring biochemical changes in the brain.
