Compulsory REVISION comments	In this excellent retrospective study, the authors get almost around a surgery procedure, known for being devastating for the patient, but which allows him or her, a small margin of survival. The study is mostly narrative. At first surprised by the repeated accent on the tumor grade, and the rare referral to the tumor stage, I believe that one should accept the mortality figures. Seventy-five to 90% died following surgery. However, we are not given the figures of the mean survival. Likewise, little information is released, concerning the sequels. When compared with western medical centres, it seems that ampullary carcinoma, in the Indian Centre, is much less frequent. My guess is the high level of vegetarian or vegan individuals
