For example, the word "recurrence" may be as "a recurrence"; "free" as "of free"; "of were" as "were"; "children, than those" as "children than in those"; "of showed" as "showed"; "of IL-6" as "IL-6"; "severity" as "the severity"; "more than" as "for more than"; "which was" as "which were"; "also at" as "also"; "composed" as "is composed"; "An informed" as "Informed"; "Tanta" as "of Tanta"; "(EEG), brain" as "(EEG) and brain"; "(hs-CRP) were" as "(hs-CRP) was"; "that chromogen" as "chromogen"; "Chi-square" as "The chi-square"; "for detection" as "for the detection"; "refractory" as "in refractory"; "than those" as "than in those"; "high" as "a high"; "in years" as "years"; "the mean" as "a mean"; "proconvulsant" as "a proconvulsant"; "of in" as "in"; "with longer" as "with a longer"; "levels was" as "levels were"; "results in" as "results are in"; "and number" as "and the number"; "of and" as "and"; "difference in" as "the difference in"; "with severity" as "the severity"; "personal" as "the personal". Minor REVISION comments	<p>1. Check the abbreviations throughout the manuscript and introduce the abbreviation when the full word appears the first time in the text and then use only the abbreviation (For example, IL-1β, hs-CRP, AEDs, etc.). And it should be in both abstract as well as in the remaining part of the manuscript. Make a word abbreviated in the article that is repeated at least three times in the text, not all words need to be abbreviated.</p> <p>2. The authors may cite references for standard protocol, instead of mentioning kid or manufacture instructions, if a reference is given with it and the same should be added in the reference section.</p>	
Optional/General comments	The authors have put effort to evaluate the "Study The Role of Pro-inflammatory Cytokines (Interleukin 1-Beta, Interleukin 6) and High Sensitivity C-Reactive Protein in Children with Refractory Epilepsy". The authors describe the work undertaken with this in an organized manner, emphasizing the results obtained by them. The article needs modification for better cohesion of information to achieve the goal and the shortcomings which need to be considered. Hence, the paper can be accepted after MINOR REVISIONS are carried out.
