Are these countries similar, homogenous? Perhaps, if differences exist, multiple estimations are required for sub-groups of countries.</li> <li>• The author should specify the program used for estimating the coefficients, and the measure units of the selected variables (% , % of GDP, \$ etc)</li> <li>• The author should explain what are the differences between the different types of estimation (Diff-GMM1, Diff-GMM 2, Sys GMM1, etc.) and the methodological differences between the short-run and long-run estimations.</li> <li>• The author should explain what is the final model for interpreting the results.</li> <li>• The author should explain the selection of the control variables? Why these and not others?</li> <li>• The author should explain why none of the control variables shows significance.</li> <li>• The author should explain abbreviations (e.g. Table 1, where we read LLEB, LGE, CHE, but we have no explanation!)</li> </ul>
