Minor REVISION comments	(1)There are some obvious spelling mistakes in the paper. Please correct them. For example, "2.1 Financial management dan financial distress";	
Optional/General comments	The study is to examine the conceptualization of financial distress research in the textile and apparel industries by adopting a qualitative approach through the literature review method. To interpret and describe the frequency patterns and relationships, text mining, network analysis, and content analysis were used. This study discovers that a frequently discussed issue is the influence of financial variables, both dependent and independent, on the prediction of financial distress or vice versa, using various quantitative approaches and models of financial distress. This study's systematic review of the literature can at least provide a comprehensive framework for the issue of financial distress in Indonesian textile and garment sector companies.
