Diabetic retinopathy needs more supportive measures and author discussed on it. Any reference for that finding? The names of the studies are stated in the last part of the preventive measures. However, no discussion based on those studies. Prognosis of Covid-19 with underlying diabetes is weakly stated in the paper with limited review.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>Grammar and spelling errors should be corrected throughout the manuscript. Some of the information like immunity, chronicity are unnecessarily repeating.</p>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>Author should improve discussion in the main area of the study (Covid-19 with underlying DM).</p>
