Please carefully proof-read spell check to eliminate grammatical errors</b></p> <p><b>INTRODUCTION: There are multiple ideas describing the same points. This section should be re-structured for more clarity. Additionally, English should be proofread before re-submitted.</b></p> <p><b>The aim is not clear and I am not sure why it has a reference.</b></p> <p>"The main aim of this study is to determine the clinical profile and manifestation of scrub typhus infection among people<sup>10</sup>".</p> <p><b>Consider changing it to:</b> "The aim of this study was to determine the clinical profile and manifestation of scrub typhus infection among patients</p> <p><b>Material and methods:</b></p> <p><b>In this section they mention they recruited cases over a period of 4 months. However, they do not mention during which season they did so, and it was mentioned in the introduction it is common during the 'monsoon season'. Also, there is not information about the year these cases were managed.</b></p> <p><b>Discussion</b> <b>Even though, the authors have included two references to the Kumar and Trowbridge studies in other sections of the manuscript they should include the reference here too. The study by Wei et al is not in the references.</b></p> <p><b>Additionally, this section is reiterative of the results section. Should include something about the male to female proportion of cases. I suppose they should have something to do with the occupational hazard or the area of residence.</b></p> <p><b>They mention about the antibiotic treatment is effective to control this infection, however, they did not mention about treatments offered to the patients. In such case, the complications reported were due the late diagnosis. Therefore, this can be expanded in this section.</b></p>
