Sentences are not in a flow. Doesn't reflect the rationale of the study. Some of the sentences have been highlighted, author should please check.</li> <li>• Aim – Vit D -----what either levels or its impact on outcome.</li> <li>• Material and Methods- Sampling technique is not given. How author has taken 40 patients.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- How it is a non-randomised controlled trial</li> <li>- No need of describing DOTS treatment here</li> <li>- Informed consent, inclusion and exclusion criteria not mentioned.</li> <li>- Description of statistical test and software not mentioned</li> <li>- Author may kindly mention the metabolism of Vit D with its pathway here systematically in this section.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Results- a table of socio-demographic profile of patients may be added.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Effect of vit D levels on the outcome of the patients can be evaluated to make the study more relevant and useful.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Discussion – more evidences from other studies need to be added. Reference no. 13 not mentioned in text. Grammatical errors need to be corrected.</li> <li>• References – to be cited according to the Vancouver style of referencing. Author may kindly check. More references need to be added. Even a short research article needs 15—20 references according to journal guidelines.</li> <li>• Overall word count of the article is approx. 2300. Author should kindly check the journal guidelines and the type of article to make it appropriate</li> </ul>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	Many grammatical errors are there in the article. Author need to correct those.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	Author may further expand the study to make it more relevant.
