Was it on a voluntary basis? If yes, then the study results could be subject to very heavy self-selectivity bias. For example, the patients who were willing to participate could have been those who were more eager to report their maternity problems, eg, abortions, poor neonatal care, etc.</li> <li>2. What kind of data was collected during the study? Did you use a survey questionnaire? If so, could you provide a copy of the questionnaire used in the study? This will help the readers to understand the suitability of the questions asked.</li> <li>3. This article is probably too short for proper investigation into the subject matter. Maybe you should wait until you have done the data analysis and report it in a subsequent research paper.</li> <li>4. Can you show us the data or evidence supporting your claim that more attention should be paid to maternal mental health, breastfeeding and neonatal development? Shouldn't this kind of attention be paid to all patients, instead of just to the COVID19 sufferers?</li> </ol>
