Compulsory REVISION comments	I appreciate the thought and idea behind the paper. Concept of the study is good. Though Major revisions are necessary. The APA rules of formatting, references and sentence in-text citations should be adhered. Need to revise the chapter sequentially and guide the reader accordingly. The chapter is currently very abrupt and not in a flow. Research questions or hypothesis are to be written clearly before the methodology. On what basis is the study accepting or refusing the results is not clear. Assumptions to the need of the study should be avoided. The sample size, the grouping, statistical testing, and the normality of the distribution are many things that are missing.	
Minor REVISION comments	Some grammatical and punctuation clarity is needed. Sentence at times is fragmented while reading.	
Optional/General comments	Good attempt at bringing the Indian children with disability and their difficulties on the fore.
