<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>In Introduction, in the last stanza, add the reason/s or explain why the study was conducted and the possible implication/impacts of the result</p> <p>Add additional tables needed to support the result such as the table for the socio-demographic profile of the respondents, table that show the difference between the SPADI score of the control and experimental group subjected to MET's approach. Although the result both shows significant change from pre-treatment to post-treatment, it is still necessary to compute whether the difference between the control and experimental set-up post a significant difference.</p> <p>Elaborate/explain the role of getting the profile of the respondents and its relationship/association in the result of the study. Does it had a significant relationship/difference or it does not have? In short, explain why the use of the profile of each respondent to the study.</p> <p>Describe clearly the characteristic of the experimental and control group and establish the non-significant of the difference between the two groups in pre-treatment.</p> <p>Elaborate clearly the Kaltenborn techniques and Maitland method whether both or only one has actually been used in the said study.</p> <p>Arrange/organize the different parts of table consistent. Try to improve the format of the content. For instance, double spacing vs single space, justify vs. not justify</p> <p>Add more explanation and related literature and studies as support to the result that MET's approach was better than the traditional approach.</p>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>In the Abstract part, revised it by making or combining all the stanza/paragraph into a single paragraph. Stating the word objectives, methodology, result, etc is not necessary since when it is written into a single paragraph, the flow of the content can be understand easily.</p> <p>In the Reference, only 5 out of 18 were published 2012 onwards which means that majority of the reference used was obsolete (although it is still useful but try to find more references from the past 10 years to come up with a latest findings on the said study.</p> <p>Try to rephrase and improve the citation of the article derived from different sources to clear the plagiarism issue.</p>
