However, for the publication of the manuscript, it is essential to revise it, so that it can be improved. So, here are suggestions:</p> <p>1 – As described in "Submissions & Author Guideline", the abstract must be structured in the following subsections requested by the journal: Aims, Study design, Place and Duration of Study, Methodology, Results, Conclusion. Also, it must not exceed 300 words in length. Authors are asked to review the manuscript abstract and make any necessary corrections.</p> <p>2 – It is suggested that the text, with the exception of the abstract, should be divided into numbered sections with brief titles. Starting with the introduction with section 1. subsections should be numbered (eg 2.1 (then 2.1.1, 2.1.2, 2.2, etc.), up to three levels.</p> <p>3 – The titles of the figures should be presented as follows: Fig. 1. Effect of different doses of aqueous extract of Folk Recipe (100, 200, 300 mg/kg) on blood glucose levels at different time intervals in normal rabbits. Therefore, authors are asked to put the titles in the format shown.</p>
