The Author should consider removing the first two statements in the Abstract while modifying the third statement as the opening statement.</li> <li>2.</li> <li>3. The Author should adhere strictly to the Journal's referencing style. ( ) was used throughout instead of [ ]. The name 'barnett' referred to in the text is not found in the reference.</li> <li>4.</li> <li>5. While case reports may not be academic, reports to be published for reference purposes should contain enough data for assessment of claims. Averaging 3 – 5 values for each of the liver performance parameters claimed could have provided more objectivity.</li> <li>6.</li> <li>7. Phytochemicals in herbs and fruits and their health benefits have been widely reported. Mentioning the phytochemicals in the herbs and other materials used, which are known to be effective in treating liver cirrhosis would help other traditional medicine practitioners living in other regions with different resources having the same phytochemicals.</li> <li>8.</li> <li>9. There is need for correction of errors in English grammar.</li> <li>10.</li> <li>11. The Author did not establish any link between the Iranian traditional healing method and sudden reference to India under 'NOTE' at the end of the paper. Since 'NOTE' is not part of subsections of Case Reports, discussions linking Iranian and Indian practices should come up in the paper under 'Discussion'.</li> </ol>
