Compulsory REVISION comments	The article presents a relevant and current theme, but shows itself to be superficial and poorly structured. It is confusing for several reasons: 1. There is no standardization of the verb tense in the writing of the article. At every moment there is doubt as to whether the study has been conducted or will be conducted. 2. In the abstract it is informed that a form was created to evaluate stress, but at no time during the article is explained the basis for the construction of this form. 3. The Introduction does not contextualize the title of the article and covers several unnecessary subjects, since they do not apply directly to the article's theme. 4. There is no logical sequence of information; it is observed that the Methods, Results, and Discussion items are erroneously inserted into the topics. 5. Regarding the sample calculation, all students who met the inclusion criteria in both schools were/will be included in the study? This is not clear. 6. The conclusion should explain about the protocol itself, not the results that will be obtained from it. 7. References are rarely cited.	
Minor REVISION comments	It is necessary to update information, such as the fact that there is no specific vaccine for COVID.
