<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p><b>1- References section should be re-written because it has a lot of observations:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Published scientific papers or published textbooks should be used instead of published websites articles.</li> <li>• The references should be updated.</li> <li>• Use all types of research papers in writing your manuscript instead of depending on case reports.</li> </ul> <p><b>2- References inside the manuscript should be arranged and become more prominent, a lot of sentences need references.</b></p> <p><b>3- Table's numbers and capitations should be mentioned.</b></p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Abstract should be re-written using clear words and phrases such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The aim sentence should be more arranged and clear.</li> <li>• The word <b>giddiness</b> it's better to use a medical word (dizziness).</li> <li>• The phrase (He was diagnosed with Left Intraparenchymal bleed in the Corona Radiata based on his symptoms and investigatory findings, he was under medical and physiotherapy management.) should be more arranged and clear.</li> <li>• The word <b>tremendous</b> could be changed into (enormous).</li> <li>• The sentence (Physiotherapy will increase the decreased ranges), I think you should clarify decreased range of what Ex: decreased ranges of movement.</li> </ul> </li> <li>2. In the introduction section some notices were observed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In the third line <b>cut off, and ischemic</b> this sentence should be (cut off, an ischemic).</li> <li>• The abbreviation (SAH) should be after subarachnoid hemorrhage.</li> <li>• The sentence (There are 1.8 million persons in India who have had a stroke.) should be grammatically revised.</li> <li>• The paragraph (Hemorrhagic stroke causes neurological symptoms such as paralysis on one side of the body (hemiparesis), arm or leg paralysis (hemiplegia), or even complete paralysis (hemiplegia), but it also causes facial palsy (facial palsy) in the early stages of muscular weakness.) has a lot of scientific errors it is needed to be revised and corrected.</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. In the discussion section:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the first line <b>this study</b> should be this case study.</li><li>• The abbreviation OPD should be written after its meaning in parentheses.</li></ul>
