Compulsory REVISION comments	It is good that the discussion section repeats the presentation of findings and does discuss/analyse them in relation to topic and objectives. However, these need to be substantiated in relation to a few stated cited literature, instead of just generalizing that according to a thorough review of the literature, the majority of studies found that education has a significant impact on the assessment of psychosocial problems faced by primary caregivers of mentally challenged children.	
Minor REVISION comments	Research design/methodology is appropriate. It is fully described by indicating the sample size and procedure through stating the inclusive and exclusive criteria. However the research design/methodology is not fully justified. The rationale for selecting the methods that have been used for data collection has not been given.	
Optional/General comments	<p>The abstract is clear and concise. However, although expected outcomes are given to assess psychosocial problems of primary care mentally challenged children, it is without a without any recommendation or conclusion.</p> <p>The Introduction is adequate and appropriate to the topic by first explaining how child psychiatry nursing is involved and the therapeutic value of nurses' interactions.</p> <p>It also clearly describes the project being evaluated and gives the statement of the problem that children rarely initiate consultations but instead parents bring them because of their maladaptive behavior which does not match their developmental stage. Valuable literature is cited but it would be appreciated to use more updated literature.</p> <p>Conclusion</p> <p>The conclusions are good in the sense that they are derived from findings which are emphatically stated. However, no recommendations are given from the conclusion and findings.</p>
