Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>1- Title : A Case of Small Bowel Intimation with Sepsis Is not adequately informative: I suggest adding more new finding details.</p> <p>2-Abstract: - A mistake "Patient information: -He....." while The main diagnosis, therapeutic intervention and outcomes: Her flexible sigmoidoscopy....."</p> <p>3- References' styles aren't uniform throughout the manuscript; for example: In the Introduction: -Only one Reference was used (Singer et al., 2016). The authors neglected checking another, important, variable set of references while writing the introduction/ background for their topic. -Reference used (Singer et al., 2016), was written in style (name & year style) different from the rest of the manuscript (number style).</p> <p>4-Aim/specific objective of this case study isn't clear at all. -What does this research seek to add? To prove? What is the new finding of this case study??</p> <p>5-Also, methodology sections are not clarified.</p> <p>6-Again, the repeated mistake: Patient information: -63 years old male admitted.... while Medical family and psychosocial history: -patient had a medical history of small bowel intimation with sepsis for 1 month. She took treatment for that but not cure. She belongs....</p> <p>7- Absence of Ethical consideration section: - No patient consent form . -No Approval of ethical research committee in the hospital where the study was done.</p> <p>8-Results section: Is not demarcated from the discussion section. (not written at all!!)</p> <p>9-Discussion: - Very old reference was used Lucius Hotchkiss 1901 -Many abbreviation needs to be clarified on first usage as: SBO, MICU, ED</p> <p>10-Conclusion : Also, vague and irrelevant. There are some contradictions: How come " <i>patient benefit from earlier surgical intervention</i> in emergency situation while the authors demand to .. <i>it is critical to consider patients' wishes. It is critical to consider patients' preferences when beginning treatment in general and offering surgery in particular, because an operation can have a major impact on quality of life...</i>"??</p> <p>11-Refernces: -ALL of them are very, very old belong to the nineties; more than 25 years ago!! -The authors couldn't find new papers to compare & demonstrate their findings?? !! -The discussion mentions 11 references while the references section includes only six references!!! Where are the remaining references??!!</p>
