The authors need to discuss the advantages and disadvantages of the surgical treatment conducted in comparison to other alternatives of treatment, providing proper references in the text.</p> <p><u>Point 03</u></p> <p>"Physiotherapy plays an important role in rehabilitation of patient with medial malleolus and patella fracture." This conclusion is inadequate. The authors cannot state that based on a one case report only, especially that the case was not followed up for a long period of time.</p>
