Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This study aims to determine the association of liver diseases with COPD to improve the well-being of these patients. The dataset was gathered from the clinical records of COPD patients who had liver diseases between 2016 and 2020 at a specific hospital in Riyadh. In Conclusion, they found that there was no relationship between COPD and liver disease.</p> <p>The first paragraph of the introduction: "In recent years, dramatic increase in the mortality and morbidity rates has been observed for COPD". The noun phrase "dramatic increase" seems to be missing a determiner before it. Consider adding an article "a/the dramatic increase". Also, it seems that there is an article usage problem here, "the mortality". Consider changing it to only "mortality".</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>I notice some grammatical problems in this article:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On Abstract line 8, I found "155 records were analyzed in this study". Consider spelling out "155" as "one hundred fifty-five" because it appears at the beginning of your sentence. Also, consider rewriting this sentence in the active voice and specifying who or what performed the action. Example: ... analyzed one hundred fifty-five records. 2. In the last paragraph of the introduction, I found "Emphysema related to AAT deficiency develops over very long period of time". The noun phrase "very long period" seems to be missing a determiner before it. Consider adding an article "a very long period".
