Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The study design is a randomised control trial and protocol should be modified to suit it. It is not just a simple comparative study</p> <p>Methodology: Recruitment into the study requires the involvement of the participants' primary physician to decide whether the person can participate in the trial.</p> <p>The risk in the intervention group who will be using the telephysiotherapy from home with only their caregivers will be very high, since medical attention will be far. I will recommend that the telephysiotherapy is also conducted in the hospital setting but under controlled conditions.</p> <p>Formation of a joint social media group (WhatsApp) to take results will lead to bias in responding. Participants are not supposed to see what others post.</p> <p>Inclusion criteria should not include cell phones and internet data possession. I will recommend that this should be provided by the study to would be participants.</p>
