Introduction to Ayusoft-CDAC software with its address should be clearly mentioned	
Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Introduction on Pathya Apathya is repeated, it should be excluded.2. Terms like 'Acharya' and 'Charak samhita ' or kashyap samhita is internationally not approved in any subject literature of article or subject protocol. So that, if the whole sentence to be marked as reference text of same author is appreciable.	
Optional/General comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Participant time line is 90 days (3 month). But Ayurved advocates 1 Ritu is 60 days (2month) . So your seasonal diet will change for each participant. In that case what is your criteria to access your aim that should be clarified.2.
