However several minor corrections must be brought before, as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The first paragraph in section "literature review" must be rewritten with comprehensible sentences.</li> <li>2) Page 4, 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph, please authors provide essential features of "cord blood stem cells": method of isolation, key phenotypic markers, current culture medium and mitogens (growth factors), expansion rate (average time for doubling and passage), lineage (bona fide hematopoietic stem cells, or else?), potential for plasticity.</li> <li>3) Page 6, Figure 1. Add a smalle text as legend, describing the usual method for "collecting umbilical cord by interviewed health professionals themselves.</li> <li>4) All the references listed must be edited by adding the volume of journal ahead of the first-last pages of article.</li> </ol>
