<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Key words: Omit "care", "cause" in key words. May add "harlequin ichthyosis".</li> <li>2. Abstract: Ichthyosis can be genetic or acquired, not simply genetic only. So mention about this needed.</li> <li>3. Introduction: While writing HI for the first time, it should be used in brackets first time with full form, e.g Harlequin ichthyosis (HI).</li> <li>4. Symptoms and signs: Some components in this section can be kept under a separate heading as "complications and sequelae".</li> <li>5. "Affected population" section can be better kept as "Epidemiological concerns" as heading.</li> <li>6. The sequence of headings/ sections should be changed from the existing sequence to "Epidemiology, Causes, symptoms &amp; signs, management".</li> <li>7. Nursing management: Omit "the most" at the start of the sentence in line no 4 in the nursing management section, as it becomes grammatically incorrect. Write "applying the special lubricants can protect the eyes" instead of present sentence in line no 8.</li> <li>8. Write "further management steps are" for "further management is as".</li> <li>9. Conclusion: Correct grammatic errors in this section. Omit "no cure treatment"; "is a most"; "initial time of care"; to mention a few.</li> </ol>
