Mucuna pruriens should be written in italics everywhere and choose either short form or complete name as per your choice but should be common through the article. 2. In abstract, material and method portion should not contain result like "where % zone of inhibition increases as the concentration of nanoparticles increases." 3. English of the article is not good. 4. Once you have mentioned the short form of nanoparticles (NP), no need to write full form again, use only NP. 5. Titanium nanoparticles were not characterized before evaluation for activity. How you can prove that nanoparticles had been synthesized? 6. In discussion portion, discuss the results of your study only, don't mention literature survey. 7. In conclusion author has mentioned "with more effectiveness and less toxicity". How author can claim that nanoparticles are less toxic as they have not performed any toxicity studies. 	
Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Reference of "Bailey and Bailey", 1976 should be avoided in the current scenario. "Ross, no date" What do you mean by no date in the reference. 2. Font is not common in the article, somewhere text is in Arial font (see page 3,4, t etc). 3. Graphs should be against white background in place of black background. 	
Optional/General comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Write ml as mL always. 2. In result section, anti-inflammatory results should come before the results of antioxidant activity.
