Minor REVISION comments	<p>Results- Frame sentences in better way. All the numbers/percentages should be written along with the parameters. E.g. In the study population, none of the subjects were underweight (body mass index (BMI)(kg/m²) <18.5 (Underweight), 16 (16%) had normal BMI (18.5 – 24.99), 38 (38%) were overweight (BMI-25 – 29.99) and 46 (46%) of the subjects were obese (BMI > 30).</p> <p>Need not to mention " 0 subjects" Doesn't make any sense. E.g Here out of the 10 subjects who had elasticity <4.6kPa (F0, no fibrosis) 10 (100.0%) subjects had 3 components of MetS, 0 subjects had 4 components of MetS and 0 subjects had 5 components of MetS.</p> <p>Conclusion- Following conclusion remark to be removed as this was not part of study- Lifestyle changes, diet and medication for components of MetS can have a favourable impact on the severity of fibrosis of the liver and progression of NAFLD.</p>
