(no reference) c. Ayurvedic, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy (AYUSH) treatment part not a single reference. 2. Vaccination part is mentioned in a very casual manner. 3. Manuscript is not giving any proper remarks with references. 	
Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In Etiology part 'which is gram positive single strand RNA virus, around 65–125 nm in diameter' is mentioned. This is RNA virus and gram positive and negative is mentioned in case of bacteria not for viruses. 2. In Transmission part 'no evidence which confirms that this infection leads to intestine or its presence in faeces.' This statement is wrong check properly this virus is isolated in faeses and cause GI infections.
