The patient is a child of 11, however the author has not made her (his) mind up, whether this is a female or a male. By the same standards, there are several mistakes, one of the most prominent concerns the histopathological picture, with the Reed-Sternberg cells being scattered among a "sea" of inflammatory cells. You often mentioned the clinical picture. However, it is of note, that Fever, Weight loss and night sweat, are accounted for the B (systemic) symptoms. The other clinical features are of less consequence. I admire your English, but suggest a further learning of the grammar.
