Compulsory REVISION comments	"Family history of coronary artery disease, drugs given prior to angioplasty [aspirin, clopidogrel, prasugrel, ticagrelor, heparin, Glycoprotein IIb/IIIa receptor antagonists], and culprit vessel" variables were not present under the result. The Authors discussed only the association of total ischemic time with ST-segment elevation resolution and mortality. They didn't discuss the association of age, hypertension, and current smoking with myocardial ischemic time. They didn't say anything about pre and post angiographic, and procedural characteristics correlating with myocardial ischemic time. Unless they did the multivariate logistic regression they couldn't say an independent determinant factor. Acknowledgments, competing interests, authors' contributions, and ethical approval should be written next to the conclusion. Some of the references were cited in brackets and some of them were cited without brackets in the manuscript. Use the reference format of the Journal of Pharmaceutical Research International.	
Minor REVISION comments	The affiliations of the Author were not mentioned in this manuscript. The title page should contain a brief title, name(s) of the author(s), and their affiliations. Under an abstract, your results look like conclusion and methods are not enough. Add the statistical analysis you used under methods. Use the abstract format of the Journal of Pharmaceutical Research International. When you want to use an abbreviation, write in a full sentence first then use an abbreviation for the next statements. For instance, NRMI in the introduction, LBBB under methods, IABP under results, etc. The grouping of participants is not clear. You should be able to define it under the methods.
