There is a lack of information about the cost of treating such patients in the the country author.</p> <p>A more detailed description of the aetiology and highlighting of traffic accidents is missing</p> <p>Please add ultrasound in the description of the imaging studies.</p> <p>Please add at the end of the introduction a clear purpose of the study.</p> <p>Case Report Please provide anthropometric data weight, height and BMI.</p> <p>Missing health information is whether the person is chronically treated for any disease?</p> <p>Please state the number of hours per day that you spend at work.</p> <p>Clinical Findings And reduces strength of cervical muscle. - How was this investigated?</p> <p>Table 2 ROM - were the measurements taken once or several times and the average was taken?</p> <p>Discussion "The clinical hypothesis was that this patient's pain, dizziness, restricted range of motion, and restrictions in activity were caused by alterations in the Muscle Energy Technique's structure and function as a result of his prolonged bed rest." - Was there an otorhinolaryngology and neurological examination to rule out other causes of these diseases? If so, by whom? The hypothesis is very bold.</p> <p>Missing anatomical and neurophysiological connections that may explain the effectiveness of the therapy.</p> <p>Conclusion "Instead of attempting to create a pathoanatomical diagnosis when pathology is not present, as is the situation for the vast majority of individuals suffering from persistent neck pain, we propose creating a functional diagnostic based on the patient's symptoms and indications." - A very bold statement not supported by the author's research. To the best of my knowledge also not supported by the appropriate scientific research. Please remove.</p>
