Compulsory REVISION comments	1.the results of the study in the abstract needs to be rewritten to highlight the salient results noted 2. there is a gross difference in the severity of the TBI and there is no patient characteristics table between the two groups for comparison to say that the improvement is due to TXA and not due to the severity of the TBI in the patients included in the TXA group 3. there is no information about how the patients were allocated into each groups 4. there is no need for charts on gender, cause of injury or severity of TBI instead provide characteristics table for the groups comparatively with statistical analysis.	
Minor REVISION comments	The article has several language errors which needs to be revised with the help of a native language speaker
