Compulsory REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Tables 1, 2, 3, and 4 should be introduced and discussed in the main text. Did table 1 list all of the marketed products or just some? Figures 1 and 3: if the figure was reprinted from a previous article, the permission to re-use it and the copyright issue should be mentioned. Did Table 2 list all of the marketed products? Reference is required for the 5th row (ketoconazole). Table 3 is incomplete. There are many studies on SLN and NLC for the treatment of fungal infection. Section 3.1 discussed the high-pressure homogenization method. This method can be hot HPH or cold HPH. The authors only mention hot HPH. Please add cold HPH by viewing some references, such as https://doi.org/10.1016/j.jddst.2019.101185 and https://doi.org/10.3109/10837450.2010.542163 Section 3.2 repeated hot HPH. The content was similar to section 3.1. Please combine them. Reference 29 was used for the solvent injection method. However, this reference was about magnetic nanoparticles, not SLN and NLC. The authors should cite other references. The references should be updated. Most of the references were before 2016. Please cite recent articles in 2017-2021. Section 3: the authors should cite more references when introducing each method. The recent articles are preferred. Please use only articles that formulated SLN and NLC instead of other types of nanoparticles. 	
Minor REVISION comments	11. There are some grammar errors and typos. Please check and correct.	
Optional/General comments	The manuscript summarized some studies on SLN and NLC for the treatment of fungal infections. The overall structure was appropriate. However, there are major issues to revise, as mentioned above.
