Moreover, it is highly recommended to include weaknesses of the study and potential future research goals in the discussion part.</li> </ol>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Check the abbreviations throughout the manuscript and introduce the abbreviation when the full word appears the first time in the text and then use only the abbreviation (For example, LDL, HDL etc.). And it should be in both abstract as well as in the remaining part of the manuscript. Make a word abbreviated in the article that is repeated at least three times in the text, not all words need to be abbreviated.</li> <li>The authors should given how many males and females are taken for the present findings since in the results percentage of male and females have been given along with the average age groups of both individuals.</li> </ol>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>The authors have put effort to evaluate the "Identify and Assess Drug Interactions with Atorvastatin in Inpatient Care". The authors describe the research undertaken with this in an organized manner, emphasizing the results obtained by their group. The article needs modification for better cohesion of information to achieve the goal and the shortcomings which need to be considered.
