Conclusion drawn without any arguments and key messages. The references are less and observed lack of enough literature review. Abstract not provide an accessible summary of the manuscript and is too short. No key words are mentioned. No discussion has been found, authors have simply summarize the information. No rationale for the information is discussed.	
Minor REVISION comments	Some grammatical and punctuation mark need to be corrected.	
Optional/General comments	The authors raised a very important issue but need to be written in a systematic manner.
