Compulsory REVISION comments	Nothing has been mentioned regarding stages and genetic predisposition of PSP .PSP is included in Parkinson's Plus Syndrome or Atypical Parkinsonism. However, PSP progresses much faster, causes more severe symptoms, responds very poorly to Parkinson's medication, and has a significantly reduced life expectancy.	
Minor REVISION comments	Differential diagnosis and symptomatology should be emphasised like weight loss and chest infections are more common in PSP whereas shaking (tremor), while prominent in about 70 percent of people with Parkinson's, occurs in only about 10 percent of people with PSP. More commonly, tremor occurring in PSP is irregular, mild and present only when the hands are in use, not at rest as in Parkinson's.
