I am confused. In fact, the author did not analyze the correlation.</p> <p>2 The conclusion: Therefore, males are healthier than females. It is not appropriate. The degree of health depends on many factors. The BMT indicator alone shows that its health is very one-sided.</p> <p>3 keywords do not reflect the paper well.</p> <p>4 In the introduction, the author said that "Respiratory motion is an abnormal rate of breath due to which causes chest pain and brain tumor (5). Is the author sure that reference 5 has a relevant reference to this sentence?</p> <p>5 The author says that the number of samples is 100. However, the total number in Table 1 is 99.</p> <p>6 What does BMP mean appeared in Figure 2?</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>1 The normal breath-hold time (BHT) is 45-55 seconds, estimated in 2014. Who is it for? Is it gendered? What is the practical significance of this value and current research?</p> <p>2 In addition to gender, students' parameters need to be supplemented, such as age, nutritional status, et al</p>	
Optional/General comments	Although BMI is a well-known abbreviation, it is recommended that the author write down the full name of MBI in Materials and methods. In addition, the abbreviation of BHT in Background: can be placed in the first sentence. After using abbreviations, breath holding time used in the paper can be replaced by abbreviations.
