Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This review article addresses the different treatment options for malocclusion after maxillofacial trauma. The manuscript contains four keywords and thirty references. Overall, it is a concise and correct manuscript.</p> <p>Specific comments on different sections of the manuscript are made.</p> <p>Keywords The manuscript presents four keywords. For keywords, where possible, please use Medical Subject Headings terms (MeSH Terms). "Malocclusion" and "facial asymmetry" are MeSH terms, not "functional therapy" or "prosthetic treatment". An alternative MeSH term proposed is "prosthodontics" better than "prosthetic treatment".</p> <p>Introduction According to the journal's guidelines, in the text, citations should be indicated by the reference number in square brackets [1], not in parenthesis (1). Please, correct this in the whole document. Abbreviations and acronyms should be explained the first time they are used, e.g. TDI. What is the meaning of TDI? It will not be TMD instead? After the following text "the jaws are closed.8" appears the number 8; is it a reference in text or a typographical error? If it is a reference, it would be number 3 and it should appear in square brackets.</p> <p>References Total number of manuscript references: 30.
