Conclusion section of the Abstract should be verified.</li> <li>3) Page 2, the sentence starting from: "An investigation of USA national cases information..." is too long and not grammatically correct.</li> <li>4) Page 2, the sentence: "Depression builds the danger of CHF..." is unclear. The abbreviation "CHF" should be defined.</li> <li>5) More details about patient selection should be included. Were all consecutive 200 patients admitted to the hospital included or were they selected from the bigger group?</li> <li>6) Page 5, the sentence starting from: "There was no statistically significant difference..." needs clarification. What was compared statistically?</li> </ol>
