Is there any specific reason that ENT and Ophthalmology departments are not included in the study or prescribe other decongestants only?. Naphazoline is used to reduce eye and nasal congestion.	
Minor REVISION comments	Few references seem to be completely of different topics like the reference No. 8 which does not involve the drug studied: Karaman K, Bostanci EB, Aksoy E, Ulas M, Yigit T, Erdemli MO, et al. Effects of dexamethasone and pheniramine hydrogen maleate on stress response in patients undergoing elective laparoscopic cholecystectomy. Am. J.Surg. 2013;205(2):213-219.	
Optional/General comments	The improper use of Naphazoline in Paediatric age has been aptly pointed out in the study which may lead to future correction in the Hospital. The data is well controlled and robust. Adequate references have been provided.
