The title does not go with the content as the paper suggests safe prescription and does not focus on the problems caused due to polypharmacy.</li><li>3. The paper's objective needs to be specified, and it should focus on that objective. It is not clear whether the author wants to discuss the problems caused by polypharmacy, its related factors, or ways to prevent it.</li><li>4. The methodology followed is not mentioned, and it is not clear what type of article it is. The study design should be explained in detail.</li><li>5. It is not specified whether the safe prescription tips given in the paper are based on any data or literature review.</li></ol>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	Few grammatical mistakes can be rectified. <i>E.g.</i> , A line in the abstract "The senior population frequently has several medical diseases and may possibly suffer from cancer, which necessitates the use of multiple drugs for therapy."
