All details under <u>Emerging Data From Covid</u> are from only one reference, no comparison. Procedure described here is routine .no mention of alterations undertaken to decrease the aerosol generation during the procedure are mentioned.</p> <p>Alterations have been undertaken by many surgeons and intensivists and one such technique has been published in IJCCM by our team for percutaneous tracheostomy (Indian Journal of Critical Care Medicine 2021;25:642-47).</p> <p>Use of PPE in covid has become well established and well known, does not need much emphasis. There are 10 references on PPE only in last three lines</p> <p>References mentioned are very few which actually discuss tracheostomy.</p> <p>Grammar and tense need much changes.</p>
