From the above, it is very clear that the number of people having low vision are increasing."- it is not correct, ??? please the citation. <b>2.4</b> "According to some studies conducted , at the age of 45 less than 1% of people are likely tohave low vision, but by the age of 75, that jumps to almost 5%, and then to 15% by the age of 85."- the reason for low vision is .....???? The given citation is not suitable. <b>2.5.</b> « The main factors contributing to this mountain of low vision aid problems are – various diseases causing it, lack of interventions, poverty due to which the poor people cannot afford it.???????????? QUOTE</p> <p>In children the diseases which lead to loss of vision are – cataract, trachoma, night blindness, glaucoma, amblyopia, nystagmus.????????
